



Carpet Beetle Removal Preparation Checklist

To ensure the effectiveness of the carpet beetle treatment, the property must be fully prepared prior to service. Please follow the checklist below to complete all necessary preparations before the technician arrives.

- Before we begin the treatment, all occupants, including pets, must leave the unit and not re-enter for a minimum of 5 hours after our technician arrives.
- Anyone who is pregnant, under 2 years old or has respiratory issues (like asthma) should leave the building for 24 hours.
- Remove any items from the floor area of bedrooms including: under beds, closets.
- Clear all, or as many, items from the floor area in all other rooms including under kitchen/bathroom counters.
- Any excess clutter, toys, books, clothes, etc should be taken off the floor; you can put them on top of a bed or table.
- Vacuum carpets, rugs, upholstery, and under furniture to remove beetles, larvae, and eggs.
- Dispose of the vacuum bag or empty the canister immediately outside the home to prevent re-infestation.
- You may leave aquariums, but make sure you turn off the filtrations and aeration systems and cover the tank with a sheet or cloth; please leave the cover over the tank for an extra 2 hours when you get back.
- When you re-enter your suite you may put the items you have moved back to where they were. Please do not wipe or mop the floors or cupboard areas that we have treated for at least 7-14 days. You may vacuum but do not use a wet towel or mop.

1. If you are still seeing carpet beetle activity 4 weeks after treatment, please contact our office for next steps.

You may open doors and windows when you first come home to air out your home.
