



## Flea Removal Preparation Checklist

To ensure the effectiveness of the flea treatment, the property must be fully prepared prior to service. Please follow the checklist below to complete all necessary preparations before the technician arrives.

- Before we begin the treatment, all occupants, including pets, must leave the unit and not re-enter for a minimum of 4 hours after our technician arrives.
- Anyone who is pregnant, under 2 years old or has respiratory issues (like asthma) should leave the building for 8 hours
- Cats and dogs should be treated with a veterinarian flea treatment, such as "Advantage".
- Clear all, or as many, items from the floor area in all the rooms. Do not worry about furniture.
- Any excess clutter, toys, books, clothes, etc. should be taken off the floor; you can put them on top of a bed or kitchen table.
- Move all furniture at least 6 inches away from the wall.
- Vacuum all floors the night before we come and dispose of the contents.
- If you have an aquarium, please turn off the filtrations and aeration systems and cover the tank with a sheet or cloth; please leave the cover over the tank for an extra 2 hours when you get back.
- When you re-enter your suite you may put the items you have moved back to where they were.
- Please do not wipe or mop the floors or cupboard areas that we have treated for at least 3 weeks. You may vacuum, but do not use a wet towel or mop.

**You may open doors and windows when you first come home to air out your home.**
